requirements have changed for the 2020-21 School Year!



Students graduating in the 2020-21 school year require **only 20 hours** of community involvement activities.



**Virtual volunteering**, such as connecting online with seniors, organizing virtual fundraising events now qualify.



**Earn hours during the day while at school!**  
Speak to your guidance counsellor to find out how.



**Earn hours by helping out at home!** Examples include walking a younger child to and from school, helping younger siblings with school work, household chores, and helping out a neighbour.



Students aged 14 years and older can earn a **maximum of 10 hours** from paid employment!
