

NEW! Community involvement requirements have changed for the 2020-21 School Year!



Students graduating in the 2020-21 school year require only 20 hours of community involvement activities.



Virtual volunteering, such as connecting online with seniors, organizing virtual fundraising events now qualify.



Earn hours during the day while at school! Speak to your guidance counsellor to find out how.



Earn hours by helping out at home! Examples include walking a younger child to and from school, helping younger siblings with school work, household chores, and helping out a neighbour.



Students aged 14 years and older can earn a maximum of 10 hours from paid employment!
